



# NAA Scholarship Guidelines

*Adopted 10/22/04  
Amended 05/01/2006*

- NAA Scholarship funds are available for attendance at NAA events and other Arborist conferences or training events so designated by the NAA Board.
- Scholarship funds available will be equal to the amount of scholarship funds raised the previous fiscal year.
- Any student currently enrolled in a trade school or college studying in horticulture or Arboricultural related field with personal interest in tree care may apply.
- Individuals new to the tree care industry may also apply. Applicants must meet the requirements for the given seminar and be new to the new industry.
- A letter of recommendation must be submitted at the time of application from applicant's instructor and/or employer.
- Allocated funds will be used to cover the seminar's regular member registration fee. Up to \$20.00 for transportation will also be allowed at the current federal IRS rate.
- Scholarship determinations are made at the discretion of the Board's President and Treasurer. (If the President is unable to make the decision, the President-Elect or Past President may serve in this capacity.)
- Applications must be received at the NAA office a minimum of two weeks prior to the event requesting scholarship for.
- Should there be any excess scholarship funds for a given year, the funds may be made available to a current Board member to fund partial expenses for attending a national tree care industry conference. Any excess scholarship funds over what was allocated for the yearly award and monies still held in reserve in the fund can be available to the Board to spend in any area the board so deems essential to the well being of the association. The Board decision to spend these funds must be unanimous.
